We're meeting at St. Mark's Lutheran Church at 550 7th St W, St Paul, MN 55102.



In what has amounted to the deadliest wildfire in California history, 90 percent of Paradise, California, has been destroyed. More than 7,600 single-family homes and 260 commercial structures burnt to the ground. Forty-eight lives lost and hundreds more missing.

Eighty homes of EFCA congregants were destroyed by the fire, leaving just two families from Paradise EFC with homes to which to return. Still, by the grace of God, all the congregants' lives were spared. We're responding, but we need your help. Along with the physical restoration, the Crisis Response team is focusing on trauma care - providing support and counseling to those who experienced this disaster firsthand.

For God's peace, comfort, hope and restoration to cover Pastor Art Worthington, Paradise EFC and all those affected by the fire in the Paradise community.
