sermon questions

1. What reason does Peter give for the importance of replacing Judas' position among the apostles?
2. What role did the Sabbath play in the social lives of first century Judaism?
3. How did the disciples spend their time while waiting on the arrival of the Holy Spirit (see vs.14)?
4. What is it that unified the disciples in the upper room and us today?
5. According to Peter, what is the criteria for the one that will replace Judas, and who fulfilled the criteria?
6. How did the disciples finalize the selection of the one who should fill the open spot with the other eleven? Is this a reliable way of making decisions (See Numbers 26:55; Psalm 22:18; Proverbs 16:33; Jonah 1:7)?
7. How important is prayer, and through prayer understanding GOD's leading?
